

1 INTRODUCTION

This Dissemination Actions Report (Result No.24) analyses the exploitation and impact achieved during the project life -from December 2016 to January 2020- by partners in events.

In this sense, spread the project in different events has been necessary to address the main dissemination objectives, and to enhance the public impact, too. Bus.Trainers has participated in different workshops, other projects meetings, congresses, conferences, fairs, workshops, international networks... All these activities have had the objective to ensure the dissemination of contents, results and products, and the Bus.Trainers know-how, to reach all potential audience at Europe (Task 9.3).

The main aim of this task was to create a permanent link with the business, sectoral, political, social and administrative stakeholders, and to achieve their participation in the technical actions of the project, and also to apply the innovative results produced. Since the partnership, we consider that this experts have been an important value to promote institutional and professional support of the project and its results.

Following, we will analyse the other dissemination activities carried out by the partnership, different from meetings, infodays and endorsement seminars established in the proposal.

2 OTHERS DISSEMINATION ACTIONS

From December 1st, 2016 to January, 31st 2020, we have disseminate Bus.Trainers in several meeting, events, workshops, conferences... to spread project outcomes internationally (Task 9.3.6). The task description of the proposal expected to present the project in some international networks: Reforme network, Conference on Project Development, Build Up Skills platform and exchange activities...

In addition of these dissemination actions, Bus.Trainers was disseminated in 6 infodays (Task 9.3.4) held during the partnership meeting (Task 9.3.1) to reinforce the project presence and influence in the different countries of the partners. **The total of attendees to these infodays were around 166.**

Together with these communicative tasks, the partnership organised 7 endorsement seminars in their different countries to establish a permanent link with the stakeholders of Spain, Italy, Greece, Malta and Portugal. **The total of attendances to these endorsement seminars were 159.**

Finally, the last dissemination activity of this task was the Final Dissemination Event (Result 25, Task 9.3.5). **To the Final Event, Bus.Trainers reached 75 attendees and 19 appearances in Media that impact more than 48,200 people.** And three news on Fundación Laboral de la Construcción corporate website that had 500,000 unique visitors/year plus four appearances in four different newsletters that achieve more than 29,000 subscribers. The project website reached 204 visitors, 240 visits and 482 page views, and in Social Media reached 412 interaction (in Twitter and Facebook). Media and social coverage exceeded 75% of the expected number of participants in Spain (20 per country, making a total of 100), with more than 110 registered.

These three dissemination actions are explained in detail in the Final Dissemination Report -section 3 'Communication actions and results', subsection 3.1 'Meeting and events'-, and together with the **other dissemination actions** explained in this report, complete the exploitation and impact work of the partnership.

To complete the dissemination of the Project, the partners presented the results, objectives and values of Bus.Trainers not only in international networks that were established at the beginning, but also in other events, conferences, workshops, congresses, etc. to ensure the scope of the initiative at European and national level.

2.1 PRESENTATION IN OTHER EVENTS (TASK 9.3.6).

Throughout the life of Bus.Trainers, several presentations of the project were made at other European project meetings, international networks, congresses, fairs, workshops and other events. The aim was to optimize and support the viability of the initiative, the achievement of aims and the transmission and transference of knowledge.

Below, we detail in chronological order the different events in which the partnership participated to disseminate the results and objectives of the initiative, with the aim of establishing synergies and ensuring the success of Eco.Trainers training.





3 CONCLUSIONS

In summary, the partnership has carried out 57 presentations of the project in several events: international project meetings (18), Build up meet (3), Training Subcommittee of FIEC (3), European forums (2), congress and fairs (15), workshops (2), local events (6), corporative internal meetings (4), infodays (2) and papers in congress (2) -one will publish on June 2020-.

In relation to the number of attendees, we have counted a reach of more than 700 people: more than 300 attendees at international meetings of other projects; more than a hundred attendees to fairs and congresses -Bus.Trainers was presented in 15 construction sector fairs or congress-, the characteristics of these type of events complicate the counting of reach, but it is estimated an average of 970 people per congress/fair; 186 attendees to local events; 36 participants in workshops; 93 attendees to corporative internal meetings; and 50 infodays attendees.

After analysing in detail the dissemination activity during the project, we have been able to reach the proposed target, which according to the analysis has been composed mostly by: project officers, VET trainers, VET centres and providers, training institutions, trainees, construction workers, sectoral professionals, entrepreneurs and SMEs, representatives of companies, policy makers, and local and national authorities; also European stakeholders of VET and construction industry, media and general public.

In short, Bus.Trainers has carried out an active dissemination strategy, participating in several events that have helped us to involve relevant stakeholders from all partner countries and to strengthen synergies with other projects.
